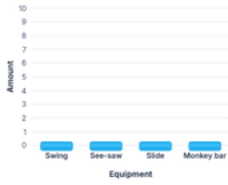
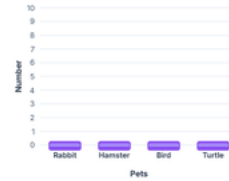

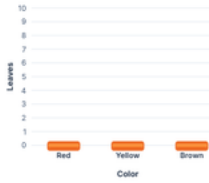
**#1** There are 6 swings, 1 see-saw, 4 slides, and 10 monkey bars at the park.



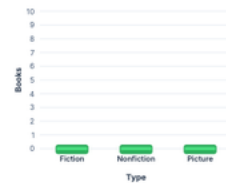
**#2** At the pet store there are 3 rabbits, 7 hamsters, 5 birds, and 2 turtles.



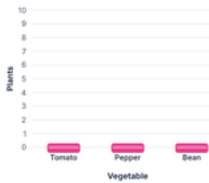
**#3** The class collected 8 red leaves, 4 yellow leaves, and 6 brown leaves.



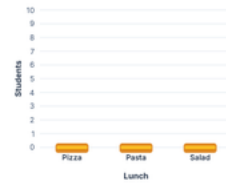
**#4** On the shelf are 2 fiction books, 9 nonfiction books, and 5 picture books.



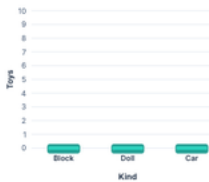
**#5** The garden has 5 tomato plants, 3 pepper plants, and 7 bean plants.



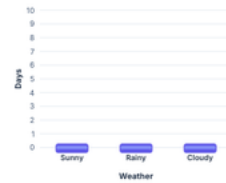
**#6** At lunch, 10 students chose pizza, 6 chose pasta, and 4 chose salad.



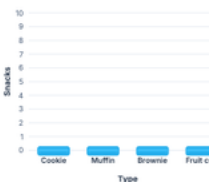
**#7** In the toy bin there are 8 blocks, 3 dolls, and 6 cars.



**#8** The weather chart shows 7 sunny days, 2 rainy days, and 4 cloudy days.



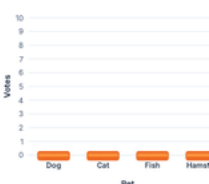
**#9** The cafeteria sold 6 cookies, 9 muffins, 4 brownies, and 2 fruit cups.
